Appendix 1: Research methods

A desk-based review. A high-level review of data sources, reports and information relating to the non-profit retrofit sector. A key data source in our desk-based review was Community Energy England's 'Community Energy State of the Sector' data (2022 and 2024). We reviewed the Charity Commission's charity register; however, our ability to wield useful results from this huge database was limited by the available search and filtering functions (see Appendix II). We explored the MCS public dashboard; but again, we were not able to get enough granularity of data to be of use.

Analysis of Community Energy England's State of the Sector data (2022 and 2024). There are two key data constraints which shaped our analysis of this data. The first is that, due to timeframe constraints, CSE undertook analysis on the 2024 dataset half-way through the collection period, meaning the response rate that analysis was carried out on was 323 organisations (2022) as compared with 124 organisations (2024). 124 is still considered a significant-enough number that sound comparisons can be drawn. The second point to note is that the survey questions asked across the 2 years has changed. Where this difference is minimal, we have made comparisons; however, in some cases the difference is too big, or certain questions are only present in the 2024 dataset, and we therefore have not drawn a comparison. We have provided some detail on our analysis of the datasets in the main body of the report, with further analysis provided in Appendix III.

Two focus groups. One delivered by Locality with their members (community organisations); and a second, delivered in partnership with People Powered Retrofit, with community energy organisations and other relevant stakeholders.

Sixteen interviews. Conducted with non-profit organisations delivering retrofit services. Organisations covered a range of geographical locations, target audiences, delivery approaches and sizes. Below is a list of the organisations that we interviewed:

Appendix 2: Charity Commission data

For the charity register unfortunately, there is no option to filter to provide those delivering retrofit work and so we tried to search using different terms with the results shown below and read the charity objectives information and activities to understand what they are delivering.

You are also not able to filter by where a charity delivers its work and so some of the results were charities registered in the UK but operating internationally. For example, charities installing solar panels in rural Africa.

Overall, there was very little that could be learnt from the data. There as some charities that list energy efficiency as a charitable objective and activities, so elements of retrofit are being delivered by a number of charities. The number of results when fuel poverty also indicates this is also a key part of a lot of charities work, however without being able to analyse the data further we are unable to determine anything else.




Figure 1. The retrofit services provided by survey respondents




Figure 2. The proportion of survey respondents who have a diversity policy in place




Figure 3. A bar chart showing the barriers to retrofit and energy advice service provision by survey respondents (number of times mentioned)
